TC/M Report

-We had a problem with the water at Quinsea plant. They called us because they were getting a lot of dirt so our workers went and flushed the lines but they still were not happy so we had to put them back on Bell Pond. The plant then ramped up the whole plant after specifically being told not to, and drained the tank at Bell Pond causing some to lose water and others to lose pressure. It took a couple of days to get back to normal. Meanwhile, the issue at Cooks Cove was caused by the turning over of the pond. The workers had to remove the screens and clean them and continue flushing lines throughout the whole town to clear them. We are aiming for the first part of next week to switch them back to Cook's Cove. This has not caused any issues with the levels in Bell Pond.

- We are changing our debit machines now and going with another company that should save us a couple of thousand dollars a year.




